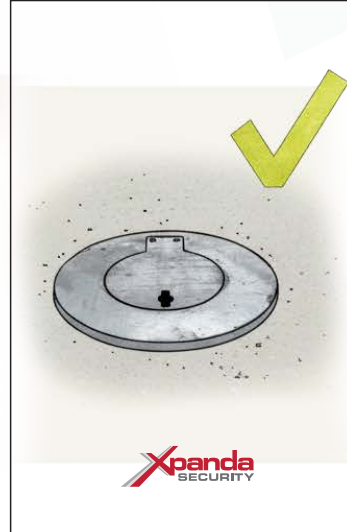


## Removable Bollards Safety & Care Guide



✓ Use your Legs

✗ Not your back

✓ Close the cover

✗ Keep it Clean

### IMPORTANT – Please Read Before Operating

To prevent injury, follow these instructions carefully.

Check your surroundings before removal – ensure there are no moving vehicles or people nearby.

Proper use ensures your bollards will last for many years with minimal maintenance.

### SAFETY FIRST

- Squat down and grip the bollard firmly near the base, lift with your legs, not your back.
- Keep hands clear of the socket edge when inserting or removing the post.
- Replace the hinged cover immediately after removal to prevent trip hazards and debris buildup.
- Always lower the post gently into the socket – never drop it.
- When the bollard is removed, find a safe storage place so it cannot fall or roll.

**WARNING:** Each Bollard post weighs around 14 kg, it can cause injury if not handled correctly.

### LOCKING AND MAINTENANCE

- We recommend you use an Abus weatherproof padlock for long life and reliable security.
- Check and clear debris, leaves, or stones from the socket before reinstalling.

### KEY CONTROL

- Restrict padlock keys to authorised staff only.
- Maintain a key register to ensure accountability and prevent unauthorised removal.
